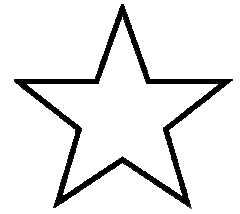
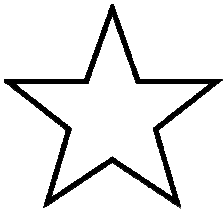

Session 2: November 7th to December 22nd

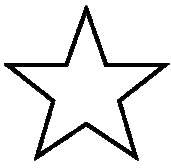
Hunt Middle School Afterschool Program got off to a great start at the beginning of the 2016-2017 school year and we are so excited to keep it going!! Many students were interested in our classes and we had great attendance. We are looking forward to the rest of the school year with existing popular programming and some awesome new classes. **The week of October 31st will be a Homework Help only week, between the end of the first and beginning of the second sessions.**

Afterschool will continue **Monday-Friday** beginning just after dismissal at **3:15pm** or **2:15pm on Wednesday**. Don't forget, we provide **supper** to all Hunt Middle School students at 3:00pm in the cafeteria. Snack is available to all students enrolled in afterschool activities. Many programs end between **4:15** and **4:30pm**, but some off-site programs might not return to school until **5:00pm**. Transportation to and from all off-site programs will be provided. After the scheduled activities finish at Hunt, join the **Sara Holbrook Teen Center** fun at the at the **Miller Center** until **5:30pm**.

The second Afterschool session will begin on **Monday, November 7th** and continue until the first winter break, **Thursday, December 22nd**. Within the brochure, please find class descriptions, class sign-ups, and the important student information and parental permission form. **Turn in your choices early, as classes will fill fast.** Drop-off your forms to the **HMS Front Office**. New afterschool sessions will begin January 9th, March 13th, and May 8th. **We will host a week of Homework Help between each session of afterschool.** There will be no afterschool on half days or during school vacations. SARA HOLBROOK TEEN CENTER

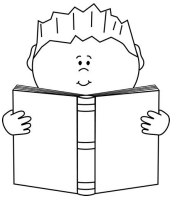

- ◆ Be committed to the classes you sign-up for and attend regularly. It is important to be a contributing part of your after school classes.
- ◆ Snack and Supper is served everyday—free of charge! Supper is served in the cafeteria at **3:00pm** and snack is taken to the individual afterschool activities.
- ◆ Transportation will be provided to and from all off-site activities.
- ◆ The **Sara Holbrook Teen Center**, at the **Miller Community Center** next to school, is open **Monday through Friday** from **3:00-5:30pm** and on **Wednesday** from **2:10-5:30pm**.

Homework Help Information & Expectations

- ◆ Sign in and sign out!
- ◆ Morning Homework Help begins at **7:00am**. Students must be in the Library by **7:30am** if they wish to attend.
- ◆ You must bring your assignment with you.
- ◆ Read a book or remain quiet after you have finished working.
- ◆ Move to a quieter area if you need it.
- ◆ Only use iPads and computers for homework.
- ◆ Let someone know if you need to go to your locker or the bathroom.
